

CLAYMONT COURT SEMINARS COVID POLICY- As of September 2022

Claymont Staff:

Claymont wants to provide as safe an environment as reasonably possible for the participants. In this time of COVID, there will always be some degree of risk of infection. The protocols aim at managing this risk for our staff at Claymont and all participants attending seminars. As part of Claymont's safety protocols all bathrooms will be sanitized each day. Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the buildings.

All Claymont staff is required to be fully vaccinated.

Guests:

Participants will honor the protocols established by Claymont and the group facilitator for persons participating in retreats.

The seminar facilitators and participants should discuss the Covid policy at the beginning of the seminar so all are informed about the policy and current Covid conditions. The discussion includes whether the whole group should wear masks or if mask wearing will up to the individual.

Claymont strongly recommends all guests be fully vaccinated. The group organizer will determine if validation of vaccination is required. All participants must obtain a Covid test with 48-24 hours prior to arrival. Proof of negative test should be submitted to the group facilitator on or before arrival.

Any guest who cannot be vaccinated should consult with the group facilitator

All persons who are flying or taking public transportation to a seminar/retreat should wear a mask while traveling to attend a seminar.

Claymont may require wearing masks indoors. This protocol will be based on current CDC recommendations and current rates of infection. Claymont requests all participants come with a mask. Wearing of masks in one's private room or outside is not required.
